

## **THAT'S REPENTANCE?!**Better Together

SERIES BIG IDEA:

We are better together when we love one another.

### I cannot separate my love for God from my love for others.

### We cannot unhitch our worship to God from our relationships with others.

<sup>21</sup>"You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'You shall not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.' <sup>22</sup>But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a brother or sister, will be subject to judgment. Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, 'Raca,' is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, 'You foo!!' will be in danger of the fire of hell.

Matthew 5:21-22 (NIV)

# This isn't about what we say, as much as it is about the angry <u>heart</u> from which we speak.

<sup>23</sup>"Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, <sup>24</sup>leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.

Matthew 5:23-24 (NIV)

# When someone has wronged me, I'm reminded to make every effort to <u>make</u> <u>peace</u> with those I've wronged.

 $^{7}$ All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."

<sup>8</sup>But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."

<sup>9</sup>Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. 10For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

# Repentance is restoring my relationship with <u>others</u> because <u>Jesus</u> restored my relationship with God.

#### **TEACHING BIG IDEA:**

Because I'm right with <u>God</u>, I work hard to make things right with <u>others</u>, as far as it depends upon me.

Knowing that I'm right with God requires me to make things right with others.

True repentance is an active <u>work</u> to restore our relationship with others because Jesus restored our relationship with God.

Our relationship with God requires us to restore our relationships with others.

<sup>15</sup>And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. <sup>16</sup>Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

James 5:15-16 (NIV)

- 1. Receive forgiveness already given from God.
- 2. Confess to the person I've wronged.
- Make <u>restitution</u> for the wrong, if possible.
   Or receive the forgiveness, if given, from the other person.
- 4. Continue to love and pray for each other.
