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TEACHING SUMMARY:

Finding the balance between truth and love is a constant struggle for many of us. For most people, one of these come more naturally. Gratefully, we have the ultimate example in Christ, Who is the perfection of both Truth and Love. In fact, Jesus was called The Truth (John 14:6) and as God was called Love (1 John 4:8). He is the ultimate example for us to follow. But, that doesn't mean it is easy.

To admonish in both truth and love first requires a relationship with Christ. Second, we must look inward to see where we need to grow. Third, we need a relationship with the person we are to admonish.

So how are you at admonishing out of love and truth? How are you at admonishing out of the love that Christ has for us and through the truth of His word? Let's dive deeper with a few questions and some great truth from God's word.
