I will pause in the daily chaos of life and turn to God to renew my soul.

## Look up. Look within. Look ahead.

<sup>1</sup>The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

<sup>2</sup>He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.

<sup>3</sup>He restores my soul.

Psalm 23:1-3 (ESV)

## A pause helps me recognize my need for Jesus and release control to Him:

- "God, I give everything and everyone to you."
- "Everything I need, I already have in Jesus."

He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Psalm 23:3 (ESV)

When I am frustrated, angry, worried, disappointed, hurt, or jealous, it's a moment to pause.

- What do I want that I'm not getting that is troubling my soul?
- Who am I looking to or what am I looking for, other than God, to restore my soul?
- What sin (unbelief, disobedience, or selfishness) is breaking my soul?

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. Psalm 23:4 (ESV)

- What am I going through that is causing fear or worry?
- Why is my fear or anxiety bigger than my faith in God?

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Psalm 23:5 (ESV)


- What God has prepared for me makes my suffering and trials worth it.
- Will I trust God to use tests, trials, and troubles to make me stronger?

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever." Psalm 23:6 ESV

God's goodness and mercy follow me only when I follow Him.

**TEACHING BIG IDEA:** 

God is always with me and I will forever be with Him.
