

CLIP 01 (02:20): (00:00:26-00:03:50)

SERIES BIG IDEA:

Jesus used culturally relevant stories to share timeless kingdom truths to lead people to God.

CUE 02: Even though Mr Holland loved music and was a talented musician he is finding that being a teacher isn't as easy as he thought it would be.

CLIP 02 (01:38): (12:50-13:11; 14:26-17:25)

This is Him struggling to find his place as a teacher but still moving forward. If this can be under 3:00 in total that would be great

Loving others isn't always easy especially when they don't respond the way we expect.

God's love for us never <u>changes</u> even when we don't respond the way we <u>should</u>.

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases. Lamentations 3:22 (ESV)

CUE 03: While the love of God never changes or ceases Mr Holland was ready to walk away until 2 conversations that changed the course of his entire life.

CLIP 03 (01:45): (21:30 - 23:35) Two conversations that changed everything

Loving others <u>requires</u> us to put others <u>first</u>.

CUE 04: In order to move forward Mr Holland had to change.

CLIP 04 (02:58): (26:30 - 29:47)

When you love something or someone you make changes

True love requires <u>sacrifice</u>.

Greater love has no one that this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. John 15:13 (ESV)

CUE 05: Mr Holland's love for music became secondary to his love for his students

CLIP 05 (03:35): (31:10-32:28; 37:07-41:11; 51:40-53:04)

A passion for music became a drive to share that with others. This is kind of a compilation of times with students. Grab what you can and maybe try to make it about 4:00

Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

CUE 06: Mr Holland's love was proven in the way he loved his son.

CLIP 06 (04:50): (55:45-56:55; 1:05:42-1:06:50; 1:50:15-1:55:19) *A father's love for his son regardless of barriers(Would love for this to be around 5:00)*

TEACHING BIG IDEA:

Love <u>sacrifices</u> for the sake of others.

In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4:10 ESV

CUE 07: Mr Holland, while never achieving fame and fortune, left a legacy of love as his symphony to the world.

CLIP 07 (04:48): (2:09:10-2:16:25)

Mr Hollands gift was himself and his impact and it created a beautiful symphony, an opus (If we could make this about 4:00-4:30 that would be great)

God's family is his legacy of love.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16 (KJV)

When we love others as we have been loved by God, we leave a legacy of love for all.
