SERIES BIG IDEA:

Jesus used culturally relevant stories to share timeless kingdom truths to lead people to God.

We are designed to experience joy.

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

CLIP 2 CUE: Welcome to Riley and her mind...

CLIP 2

Riley's mind/memories/personalities

What we think influences what we say and how we act.

⁸ Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. ⁹ Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

CLIP 3 CUE: When life turns upside down after a move, her emotions start to misfire

CLIP 3

Circumstances cause Riley's emotions to start to become dysfunctional

Joy is unattainable if we allow circumstances to control us.

CLIP 4 CUE: If we don't have a solid foundation our circumstances will end up becoming the influencer in our lives

CLIP 4

Joy is hard to hang on to when circumstances are hard.

⁹ As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. ¹⁰ If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in His love. ¹¹ I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

John 15:9-11 (NIV)

Separation from God prevents us from experiencing true joy.

Sin separates us from God.



CLIP 5 CUE: Without Joy, Riley succumbs to depression and despair

CLIP 5

Disconnect from Joy disrupts our lives.

Joy is not the opposite of sadness.

² Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³ because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. ⁴ Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

James 1:2-4 (NIV)

CLIP 6 CUE: We discover that we cannot will ourselves into being joyful.

CLIP 6

Joy and Sadness run into Bing Bong but Joy gets lost trying to do things on her own power

In Christ we have a completed mature joy that transcends understanding.

CLIP 7 CUE: Joy discovers that part of understanding joy is to embrace the other emotions instead of shutting them out.

CLIP 7

Joy realizes that Sadness has a part to play

Complete joy is found when I fix my eyes on Christ.
