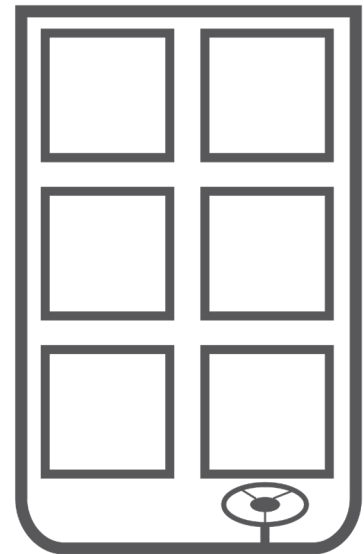

Anytime we talk about difficult issues that statement is something that we must lean into. We must look at how Jesus lived, loved, and led and see how we are to live in relationships, love at all times, and lead those we have influence with.
