

SERIES BIG IDEA:

We are forgiven so we can be given for Jesus, for His church, and for our cities.

Our purpose is to become like Jesus (<u>universal</u> calling) and use our gifts to be a gift to the church (<u>unique</u> calling) so we fulfill God's purpose.

¹⁸Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Discipleship is following Jesus together in community to grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus as our Savior and Lord.

¹¹So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹²to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

Discipleship is our mission and the method we use to experience the full measure of God.

- Jesus uses the body of Christ to equip me to follow Jesus.
- Jesus uses me to equip others to follow Jesus.

I will discover my gift in APEST.

- The apostle sends and extends.
- The prophet questions, critiques, and calls people to be faithful to God.
- The evangelist invites and gathers.
- The shepherd <u>protects</u> and <u>provides</u>.
- The teacher explains and organizes.

I will use my unique spiritual gifts.

⁴For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. ⁶We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.
