SERIES BIG IDEA:

Ephesians 2:4-6 (ESV)

*I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.*

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)

<sup>11</sup>Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called "the uncircumcision" by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands — <sup>12</sup>remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. <sup>13</sup>But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

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### TEACHING SUMMARY:

It is hard for many people to receive praise. For some, it is because they don't believe certain things about themselves. For some, it is because they don't believe the person speaking. For others, it is because they don't think the person speaking has a clear understanding of who they really are.

Jesus is someone who we can always trust, knows us better than we know ourselves, and will never say anything untrue.

Jesus invites us to sit with Him in the presence of God by repenting of our sin, submitting to Him as Lord, and receiving Him as Savior.

Jesus invites us to sit with Him and hear what God has to say about who we are to Him.

He invites us to sit and learn who we truly are.
