

Ephesians 6:10-18

SERIES BIG IDEA:

I am empowered with a grace swagger as I <u>sit</u> in the presence of God, <u>walk</u> in His Spirit, and <u>stand</u> firm against the attacks of the enemy.

- We understand the power of grace as we sit in the presence of God, let His Spirit fill us, and show us our true identity.
- My Grace Swagger is a <u>walk</u> of humility, gentleness, and patience.
- My Grace Swagger is founded in a strength that is not my own.

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty strength. Ephesians 6:10 (NIV)

I am equipped to stand firm in Grace Swagger by the Holy Spirit.

¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of the dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Ephesians 6:11-12 (NIV)

I stand firm in Grace Swagger by putting on the full armor of God.

¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground and after you have done everything to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, which which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Ephesians 6:13-17 (NIV)

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.
