SERIES BIG IDEA:

Believing that Jesus the Messiah is the Son of God and King of all is the beginning of new life in Him.

TEACHING BIG IDEA:

Jesus wants me to see as He sees and see Him as He is.

- When I see as Jesus sees, I will do as Jesus does.
- When I see who Jesus is, I will have the courage to trust in what Jesus does.

³¹ ...Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat.

³²And they went away in the boat to a desolate place by themselves. ³³Now many saw them going and recognized them, and they ran there on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. ³⁴When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things.

Mark 6:31-34 (ESV)

- The disciples see an interruption to their solitude.
- Jesus sees the people as sheep without a Shepherd.

³⁵And when it grew late, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a desolate place, and the hour is now late. ³⁶Send them away to go into the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat." ³⁷But he answered them, "You give them something to eat." Mark 6:35-37 (ESV)

- The disciples see the people's need as a problem.
- Jesus sees the possibility.

³⁷ ...And they said to him, "Shall we go and buy two hundred denarii worth of bread and give it to them to eat?" ³⁸And he said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go and see."

Mark 6:37-38 (ESV)

- The disciples see what they lack.
- Jesus sees what they posses.

"Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?" Mark 4:41 (ESV)

⁴⁸ ...He meant to pass by them, ⁴⁹but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out, ⁵⁰for they all saw him and were terrified. But immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid." ⁵¹And he got into the boat with them, and the wind ceased. And they were utterly astounded, ⁵²for they did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened.

¹³Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" ¹⁴God said to Moses, "I am who I am."

⁶The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness

²⁰And he said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. ²¹For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, ²²coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. ²³All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."
