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#### **TEACHING SUMMARY:**

Discipline isn't a fun word. For many of us, it brings up thoughts of difficult moments and often gets us thinking about the punishment we have received.

But that isn't God's plan. God's plan for discipline is one that, while including punishment, doesn't stop there. It restores us to right standing with both God and others.

Reconciliation with God and others sounds great, but it doesn't happen naturally. It takes the hard work of confession and repentance. So how are you doing in your relationships with God and others? Are you willing to confess and repent when you have sinned against God or wronged your brother or sister?

Our kids will be watching and following our lead. Let's lead them toward reconciling with others and equip them with an example of confession and repentance so they can follow and walk in the way of love.
