TEACHING SUMMARY:

Each of us is on a journey of faith. God is leading us to know Him and His love for us, and He wants us grow in our faith by responding to His grace and love for us.

As we learn about God, we discover He is generous, and we respond to the grace of His generosity by learning the spiritual discipline of giving generously.

The Apostle Paul inspires and challenges the Corinthian church with the generosity of the impoverished Macedonian church. Paul celebrates the Macedonians' heart of generosity in spite of their poverty and difficulties.

We learn that God is more concerned about the heart we give from than He is concerned to whom or to what we give. God wants His people to excel in the grace of giving by giving themselves first to Jesus and being surrendered to Him as Lord.
