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TEACHING SUMMARY:

Desires and intentions are similar. Intentions are a little greater than desires and involve an internal commitment or plan. However, a desire or intention without action is powerless and even pointless.

True generosity begins with a desire, and it is matched with the action of giving. When desire and action align with God's purpose, they are powerful.

The church at Corinth made a commitment to give and were the first to share their desire to give, but they didn't finish the work. The Apostle Paul encourages them to have the same desire from last year, but this year, put action to that desire.

Every Christian is to share in the desire and share in the action of giving generously to advance God's kingdom. This is the unity we have because of what Jesus did for us. He demostrated God's gracious generosity by becoming poor so that we could inherit the riches of God's kingdom in eternity.
