# **TEACHING SUMMARY:**

It is easy to tell people, "I'll pray for you." It takes more courage to ask, "May I pray with you right now." The church is God's family who knows that God is with us when we gather together.

When we gather together, we can share Jesus and God's power with one another by praying together. However, we pass up the opportunities to pray with each other for many reasons. Maybe it's an insecurity, a lack of knowledge, or a lack of time. For some, it may be that we don't believe God works through our prayer.

Jesus teaches that God is present in the smallest gathering of two. He teaches that God is eager for us to join God in His work through prayer.
